Sub:- Renewal of permission for admission of 5th batch (150 seats) of Venkateshwara Institute of Medical Sciences, Gajroula, Uttar Pradesh under Sri Venkateshwara University, Gajroula, Amroha, U. P. u/s 28 to be read with Section 61(2) of NMC Act, 2019 for the academic year 2020-21.

Sir/Madam,

This is in continuation to letter No. MCI-34(41)(R-112)/2019-Med./122420 dated 21.09.2020 and your reply dated 22/09/2020 with regard renewal of permission for admission of 5th batch of 150 MBBS students at Venkateshwara Institute of Medical Sciences, Gajroula, Uttar Pradesh submitted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 to now dissolved Board of Governors in Supersession of the Medical Council of India. It is brought to your notice that the Central Government has on 24th September 2020 notified fully the NMC Act, 2019. Section 61(2) of the NMC Act, 2019 provides as under:

"Notwithstanding the repeal of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, the educational standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under."

2. Accordingly your application was processed u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 and Establishment of New Medical Colleges Regulations, 1999. I am directed to convey the permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board of the National Medical Commission for renewal of permission for admission of 5th batch of 150 (one hundred and fifty) MBBS students of Venkateshwara Institute of Medical Sciences, Gajroula, Uttar Pradesh u/s 28 read with section 61(2) of NMC Act, 2019 for the academic year 2020-21.

The permission is subject to:

- (i) Submission of Affidavit from Managing Trustee/president/ Managing Director /Chancellor of Trust/ Society/ Company/ University towards rectification of deficiencies.
- (ii) Establishment of BSL-II Lab for testing of COVID-19 patients.

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3. The next batch of students in the MBBS course shall be admitted only after permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board of the National Medical Commission for renewal as per regulations that would be framed under section 26 and 28 of the NMC Act, 2019.
4. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under NMC Act and regulations made there under.
5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of the Medical Assessment & Rating Board and the State Government.
